Proverbs 29:25
Fearing people is a dangerous trap,
but trusting the Lord means safety.

Romans 3:18
They have no fear of God at all.

3 CATEGORIES OF FEAR OF MAN

1.

Matthew 10:28

Don't be afraid of those who want to kill your body; they cannot touch your soul. Fear only God, who can destroy both soul and body in hell.

2.

Hebrews 4:13

Nothing in all creation is hidden from God. Everything is naked and exposed before his eyes, and he is the one to whom we are accountable.

3.

John 12:43

For they loved human praise more than the praise of God.

How do we know we if we are caught in the trap of fearing man?

Summary: We fear man because we do not fear God or we do not fear Him enough.
