



All-Powerful – Lesson 3

Order of Service (Skit)

1) Introduction

2) Welcome & Memory Verse

Welcome back to Tree House. We have really been learning and growing together. It's so exciting to get to learn so many new and amazing things about God! I'm _____ and I am really happy to see all of you today. Who remembers the verse that we learned last week? Let's see if we can say it together.

Things (start with overlapping hands out in front of you palms up and move them apart)

That are impossible (bring your arms up crossed like an X in front of your body and then down and out away from each other)

With (bring fists together)

People (hold up both index fingers, like people, and move them in a circle)

Are possible (both fist nod like "yes" in front of you)

With (bring fists together)

God. (point up)

Luke 18:27

Awesome job! I can tell you've been practicing in your classrooms and at home. It's so great that we can come here and learn more about God through God's Word. Today, we have another example of just how powerful God is. Let's all sit on our carpets and put on our listening ears.

3) Skit

Roles: Storyteller
Superhero

Props: cape, letter to pin to shirt

Storyteller: The last few weeks, we've been learning about some of the miracles that Jesus did. We learned about one miracle that happened at a wedding. And last week, we learned about a miracle that happened in the middle of a lake.

(Hero goes to front of stage and practices flying)

Hero: **Look!** I wanted to show you my trick! I have been practicing. (Jumps from bottom step to floor as flying.) **ZOOOOM!** (Strikes hero pose - hands on hips.) I am **Super Sparky!** I've come to save the day! Ta da! (Runs across in front of stage on floor holding cape as if flying.) **ZOOOOM!**

Storyteller: **Hi, Super Sparky! What are you doing?**

Hero: **I am zooming! I have super powers! I am here to rescue the whole world!** (Strikes hero pose.)

Storyteller: **Really? How are you going to do that?**

Hero: **See my cape?** (Turns around to let cape show.) I am a **Superhero!** I am great! I have super powers! I am here to rescue the whole world! (Pose.)

Storyteller: **Really? That would take a powerful superhero. Are you sure you can handle it?**

Hero: **Of course! I have super powers!**

Storyteller: **Well, suppose I fall and get hurt. What would you do?**

Hero: (Pause.) **I am not that kind of superhero.**
(Changes pose.)

Storyteller: **Oh, let's try this. What would Superhero Sparky do if I were afraid? Maybe there was a storm and I was scared. What would you do then?**

Hero: (Pause.) **I am not that kind of superhero either.** (New pose.)

Storyteller: **I see. What if everyone here was hungry and had not eaten all day and we had no food. What would you do then?**

Hero: **I am a superhero, not a cook!**

Storyteller: **Well, what kind of superpowers do you have?**

Hero: **I can ZOOM!** (Pose.)

Storyteller: **I am not sure that ZOOMING is a superpower. But I know someone way better than any superhero who has real power. He really helps people. He can do amazing miracles! He can stop storms, and he can help us with anything. He has the power over all things!**

Hero: **Really? All things? Who can do that? Who is ALL-powerful?**

Storyteller: **Boys and girls, let's tell Super Sparky who changed water to wine and stopped the storm.** (Encourage kids to say Jesus loudly. Hold your hand up to your ear and encourage them to shout the answer even louder.) **That's right. It is Jesus! Jesus has real power. He is all-powerful!**

Hero: **But what about feeding everyone in this room? That would take a lot of super power! And a really big kitchen!**

Storyteller: **That's our story today. Jesus fed more people than are in this room. More people than are in our church this morning. And he did it without a big kitchen!**

Hero: **How did he do that?**

Storyteller: **Well, Jesus was with his disciples, and as he was teaching, a large crowd had gathered. When it came close to meal time, the disciples saw how large the crowd was and told Jesus that he should send the people away so they could get their own food. Jesus did not send them away, and he told the disciples to give them something to eat.**

Hero: **The disciples must cook like me. I can super zoom (runs across stage) but cooking not so much.** (Shakes his head.)

Storyteller: **Yes, well, the disciples tried to explain to Jesus that there were too many people there. They only had five loaves and two fish, and that would not be enough to feed the over 5,000 people that were there! But Jesus told the disciples to have everyone sit down, and then he took the bread and the fish and he thanked God the Father. Then, he broke the bread into pieces and handed it to the disciples. The disciples set it in front of the people, and all the people ate as much as they wanted and their tummies were full.**

Hero: **Hold up! You are saying that Jesus fed over 5,000 people with just five loaves and two fish?**

Storyteller: **That's right, and they even had leftovers. It was a miracle, something amazing that only God could do. The truth is, no one on the planet has super powers like Jesus. There is only one source of true power, and that is Jesus. Jesus is all-powerful, and we can pray and ask him to help us do anything. "Things that are impossible with people are possible with God."**

Hero: **Wow! No one superhero I know has that kind of power. Jesus really is better than any superhero! He is all-powerful!**

Storyteller: **Yes, he is! Let's pray.**

Dear God, you are all-powerful, and you can do anything. Help us to have faith in your power and know that you are in control. Help each of us to love others like you love us. Amen.

(Actors move to side, worship leader should begin song quickly – only stage lights. House lights up to medium so leader can see kids.)

4) Songs

What a great thing to know! I don't know about you, but that makes me really excited to see how powerful God is. You know, I feel like singing some songs—would you guys help me?

5) Prayer & Closing

Wow, God is so cool! It is so great that we get to worship an all-powerful God who loves us so much. Before you go back to your class, let's pray together.

Thank you, Jesus, for reminding us that you are all-powerful and that you give us everything we need. We love you very much! Amen.
