Order of Service (Skit)

1) Introduction

2) Welcome & Memory Verse

Hey, everybody! Welcome to the Tree House! Who is excited to be here today? That's great! My name is _____ and I am excited to be here and get to know more about God with all of you.

Speaking of learning about God, do any of you remember the memory verse we've been learning? Who thinks they can say it without any help? (Pick a few children who say they can from the audience to come on stage.)

“He (point up)

forgives (one hand with palm up in front of you and the other hand cupped facing down and moving forward and back over the palm up hand)

all my sin (index fingers make hooks and make circular motion palms up).

He heals (both hands make a grabbing motion up just below the shoulders and then pull hands down and away from body)

all my sickness.” (rub tummy)

Psalm 103:3.

(Note: See ASL video online for the words “forgive,” “sin,” and “heals.”)

Good job, guys! Let's all say our verse together
(Repeat using motions above)

You guys are great! Everybody sit back down, please.

Well, we've been learning about some people

who had some pretty big problems. But Jesus did some pretty amazing things in their lives. Do you remember the man who couldn't walk, so his friends cut a hole in the roof? What did Jesus do for him? (He healed him so he could walk again!)

And then there was a very sad father whose daughter had died? What did Jesus do for him? (He brought her back to life!) Good job!

And last week we learned about a man who was born blind. Do you remember what Jesus did for him? (He healed him so he could see!) That was pretty awesome, wasn't it?

Here come Zip and Willow to tell us about yet another amazing thing Jesus did.

3) Skit

**Roles: Zip
Willow**

Willow: Hey, Zip, how are you today?

Zip: I am great! I've been thinking a lot today, and decided I want to be a teacher.

Willow: Really? That's cool! So what do you want to teach?

Zip: I want to teach about “Thanking Jesus” for caring.

Willow: Well, I would think when Jesus did something for us, we would always thank him.

Zip: Do you think that everyone thinks that way?

Willow: I'd say so.

Zip: Well, then I have a true story that will blow you away.

Willow: **Really? What is it about?**

Zip: **This story is about Jesus and 10 sick men who had really bad boo-boos all over their bodies.**

Willow: **Oh no, what happened?**

Zip: **They asked Jesus to take the time and care about them, and heal them.**

Willow: **So what did Jesus do?**

Zip: **He sent them on their way, and as they turned to leave, Jesus healed them.**

Willow: **Were they happy?**

Zip: **I guess. Jesus healed them all. I know I'd be happy.**

Willow: **Is that the end of the story?**

Zip: **No, silly. When they were leaving, a really neat thing happened.**

Willow: **(Excited.) What?**

Zip: **One of the 10 men turned back, and went over to see Jesus.**

Zip: **What's that?**

Willow: **I think I just went on my way.**
