Willow

Willow: **Oh, I am so excited!**

Zip: **What? What is so exciting?**

Willow: **It's the most incredible day ever—it's EASTER!**

Zip: **Even more incredible than Christmas? Christmas is Jesus' birthday, and we get presents on Christmas. I just love presents!**

Willow: **Christmas is great, and it is when we celebrate Jesus being born, but Easter is when we celebrate what he did.**
