



Promotion Lesson – God’s Glory

Order of Service (Skit)

1) Introduction

2) Welcome

Worship leader will welcome children and move directly into the skit.

3) Skit

Roles: Storyteller
Zip
Willow

Props: 12 attribute balloons (1 of 12 attributes written on each balloon)
1 large bucket

Storyteller: **Hey friends! I am so excited to see you all today. I’m _____ and I’m glad to be here hanging out with you. Let’s think about some of the rules we want to remember in Big Group so we can all have a great time.**

- 1. Stay on your carpet** (stomp feet on floor).
- 2. Look this way** (look through hands like glasses).
- 3. Be good listeners** (cup ears).

Awesome! Let’s say those again; repeat after me. (Repeat rules.)

- 1. Stay on your carpet** (stomp feet on carpet).
- 2. Look this way** (look through hands like glasses).
- 3. Be good listeners** (cup ears).

Okay, guess what! I was just having a conversation with Zip and Willow. You guys remember them, right? Let me call and see if they are still in the tree house. Zip? Willow? (Calling out to Willow and Zip.)

Zip: **Hey _____!**

Willow: **Hey _____. How are you?**

Storyteller: **I am doing great, what are you guys talking about?**

Willow: **We went to a baseball game last night and saw really cool fireworks!**

Zip: **I’ve never seen fireworks as awesome as the ones we saw last night. They were so bright and colorful!**

Storyteller: **Wow! What kind of fireworks were they?**

Willow: **They were big and bright; they were the brightest fireworks I had ever seen!**

Zip: **Me, too. The first fireworks were small, but then they got bigger and bigger. Until finally it seemed like the whole sky was lighting up with them.**

Storyteller: **Wow! That sounds beautiful. I wish I could have seen them.**

Willow: **It was the best night ever. I will never forget all of those fireworks!**

Storyteller: **That reminds me of God.**

Zip: (Pause.) **How? Were there fireworks in the Bible?**

Storyteller: **No, Zip. There were no fireworks in the Bible. But, the Bible talks a lot about God’s character.**

Willow: **My teacher just told us that we’ll be talking a lot about God’s character this year in Tree House!**

Zip: **Oh, yeah! She said we’ll be learning that**

God is our Creator, and he's relational, and a whole lot more.

Storyteller: **You're right! He's also holy, and generous, and provider, and you're right—even more!**

Willow: **Well, what does that have to do with fireworks?**

Storyteller: **Remember how you said the fireworks started out small, but as you kept watching them, they got bigger and bigger until it seemed like they filled the whole sky?**

Willow: **Yeah, it was so cool!**

Storyteller: **God is the same way. As you learn more about who God is, you discover more about God's character. Then, like the fireworks, you realize that God's glory cannot be contained! The fireworks seemed to fill the whole entire sky when you were watching the baseball game, right?**

Zip and Willow: **YEAH!**

Storyteller: **This is a good picture of God's character. He has so many wonderful characteristics that not even the whole sky could hold them all!**

Zip: **WOW. God sure is big and powerful!**

Storyteller: **He is, Zip! Let me show you an example of how big and powerful he is.**

(BALLOON EXAMPLE:)

Storyteller: **See all these balloons? These represent who God is! God is all-powerful** (hold up the “all-powerful” balloon and then place it in the bucket). **God is our Creator** (hold up the “creator” balloon and then place it in the bucket). (Continue this process until all the attributes are in the bucket). **Look at all these balloons. See how the bucket can't hold them all because there are so many? This is just like God! We can't contain all his glory; he is amazing! The more we know about God, the more we are in awe of him. Kind of like when we “ooh” and “ahh” over fireworks. Our awe of God is part of our worship of him. Another way we worship is to sing to him. Stand up with me and let's sing together.**

4) Songs

It's going to be so much fun learning more about God's character this year in Tree House. It's cool to think about how **BIG** God is and how much he loves us, isn't it? Let's all stand up and celebrate how awesome God is!

5) Prayer & Closing

Wow! You guys did a great job singing praises to God! Everybody sit back down and let's pray.

God, you are amazing. Thank you for your glory. You have so many great qualities and we are thankful for you! We praise you with all of our hearts. Amen.
