



This is a story from the Bible.




God made a beautiful garden

were happy living in the garden.




God put trees in the garden that produced fruit for Adam and Eve to enjoy, but he gave them one rule!




The rule was, “You can eat the fruit of any tree in the garden—except the tree of the knowledge of good and evil.”




One day,  
the serpent is in the garden.




He is evil and tries to trick Eve by telling her she should eat from the tree of knowledge of good and evil.




Eve has a choice—she can believe the serpent or she can believe God.
