Memory Verse: Genesis 1:1 “In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth.”

Key Point: God created everything!

Bible Verse: Genesis 1:20–25

SCHEDULE:

Lesson

Five Finger Gospel (optional)

LESSON:

This is a story from Genesis 1 in **the Bible** (1). Let's find out what God created **on day five**.

Then **God said**, “**Let the waters swarm with fish and other life** (2). **Let the skies be filled with birds of every kind** (3).” So God created great sea creatures and every living thing that scurries and swarms in the water, and every sort of bird—each producing offspring of the same kind. And **God saw** that **it was good** (4).

Then **on day six**, **God said**, “**Let the earth produce every sort of animal** (5), each producing offspring of the same kind— livestock, small animals that scurry along the ground, and wild animals.” And that is what happened. God made all sorts of wild animals, livestock, and small animals, each able to produce offspring of the same kind. And **God saw** that **it was good** (6).

Let's review all that God has created so far! **On day number one**, **God created day and night**. And **on day number two**, **God created the sky** (7) to separate the waters. **On day three**, **God made all the dry land**, formed **the seas**, and created **the plants and trees** (8) that grow on the land. **On day four**, **God created the sun, moon, and all the stars** (9). **On day five**, **God created the fish** of the seas **and the birds** of the air. And **on day six**, **God created the animals** and creatures **on the land** (10). And God saw that it was good! Next week we will continue learning about what God created on day six and what he did on day seven.
