Big Idea: God places people in authority over us because He knows what is best for us.

Discussion Questions: Scripture Used: Ruth 3: 5-6

- What was Ruth's response to Naomi? Look at Ruth 3:5-6 as a clue
- Is obedience important to you?
- Who do you feel like you are obedient to? Who are some people you feel like you are not obedient to?
- When you *have* been obedient in the past, how has it benefited you?
- What is one way you feel like you need to be more obedient to God this week (*obeying with a joyful heart, kindness to siblings, inclusive to friends, not gossiping, etc.*)?

Mosaic Questions:

Please incorporate these questions into your above discussion

1. What does obedience mean?
2. What was one way that Ruth was obedient to Naomi?
3. Who are some people that you are supposed to be obedient to?
4. What did the teaching say is more important - obeying the authority that God has given us, or doing what we want?



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Small Group Activity:

Supplies:

- One blindfold or handkerchief per group
- One pen or pencil per group

Instructions:

- Pick one student to put on the blindfold
- Give them a pen or pencil
- Have a leader direct them to complete the maze below while blindfolded. (Print as many copies as you would like if you want multiple students to try the activity, or have different students use different colored pencils)
- Share with the group: sometimes it can be hard for us to obey God, especially when we can't see where He is leading us. But, if we listen to His guidance through His word, and those He has put in leadership over us, He will direct us on the right path.



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
