

Activity 1

God is Good

Have the kids cut out magazine pictures that show God's goodness. Have them think of creation and how God is good and loving to us like you talked about. Use glue sticks to make a collage on their boxes or bags. They can take this box/bag home and put reminders in it as they continue to see how God is good.

Supplies: magazines, scissors, glue sticks, boxes or brown paper bags
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Activity 2

“And It Was Very Good” Wall Art

Help the kids draw some of the wonderful things God created and said was good. Use a Bible to help.

Supplies: chalk, Bible, large piece of butcher paper or chalkboard wall
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Activity 3

Fruit Race

Make a line down the middle of the room with masking tape. Have the children stand on one side and give them each a fruit cutout from Circle Time. Place a basket about 20 feet behind the other side of the line. The objective is for the kids to put their fruit in the basket while dodging "temptations." Use student helpers to be "temptations" – they will try to tag kids before they get to the basket. Any kid who gets tagged must go back to the other side of the line and try again. Explain that the "temptations" represent things that keep good fruit from growing inside us.

Supplies: fruit cutouts from opening activity, basket, masking tape

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Activity 4

Memory Verse Card

Give each child a verse card to decorate. Go over the memory verse a few times with the children.

Supplies: magnetic sleeves, verse cards, stickers, crayons

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
