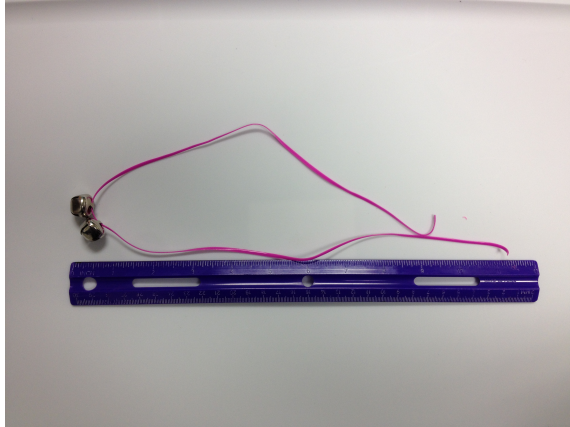
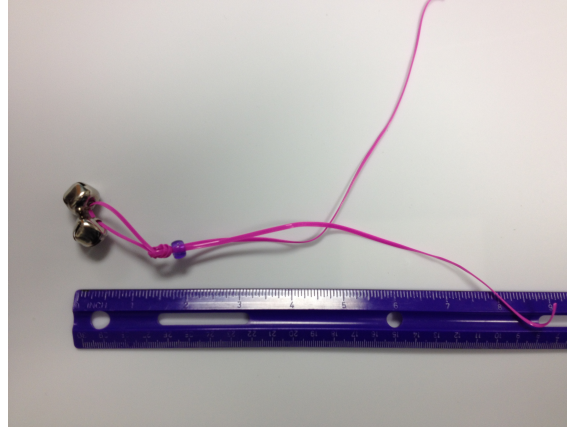


# Center I

## Joyful Noise Bell Chime Instructions



1. Cut a piece of plastic lacing cord about 22" long. Have the child thread 1-2 bells onto the cord and push the bells to the middle, as seen in the picture.



2a. Tie a knot in the cord about 2 inches from the bell. (You should be able to hold the knot at the top of the pot with the bells reaching just under the opening of the pot.)

2b. Thread a pony bead onto the cord, sliding it down to the knot. (This will go inside the pot and act as a stopper to help the bells stay in place.)



3. Put the two loose ends of the cord through the hole in the pot, thread another pony bead onto the cord, and tie a knot at the top of the bead to hold it in place. Then tie the two loose ends together to create a loop that can be used for hanging the chime.
