Questions

1. Did God fulfill His promise to make Jacob into a great nation?
2. Why did Pharaoh (the king of Egypt) fear the Israelites?
3. What did Pharaoh do to the Israelites?
4. What did Pharaoh tell the midwives to do with any babies who were born?
5. Did the midwives obey? Why or why not?

Answers

1. Pharaoh made all of the Israelites into slaves, but they continued to have large families.
2. The midwives refused to obey Pharaoh because they loved and feared God.
3. Pharaoh was afraid the Israelites would overpower the Egyptians.
4. God made the Israelites into a great nation and fulfilled his promise to Jacob.
5. Pharaoh told the midwives to kill all baby boys as soon as they were born.
