

Remembering His Faithfulness

Teacher's Guide

Isaiah 41:14 “For I am the LORD, your God, who takes hold of your right hand and says to you, do not fear; I will help you.”

- Example: Camper was afraid because parent/grandparent was sick but God helped them to not be afraid and to trust in Him

Romans 8:28 “And we know that in all things God works for the good of those who love him, who have been called according to his purpose.”

- Example: Camper did not understand why they had to move when they were younger, but now they have a great group of friends and can see God had a good plan for it

Philippians 4:13 “I can do everything through him who gives me strength.”

- Example: Camper needed to be strong when their little brother/sister was hurt so that they could help him/her

Romans 15:5 “May the God who gives endurance and encouragement give you a spirit of unity among yourselves as you follow Christ Jesus.”

- Example: Camper was going away to camp, but was scared and did not want to go, but God provided endurance and encouragement to make it through the weekend (which ended up being a lot of fun!)

Psalms 119:28 “I weep with sorrow; encourage me by your word.”

- Example: Camper has gone through a tough time (death, moving away, etc) and is sad, but God's word encouraged him/her

Situations Guide

1. Jack and his friends are playing a game at recess. A classmate comes over and asks Jack if he can play with them. Jack's friends say they don't want him to join, so Jack tells him no.
2. Sarah's teacher asks her to be in charge of getting the classroom cleaned up before the school day is over. Sarah picks people to do different tasks, and together they get the room cleaned up.
3. Brian is playing baseball and his team ends up losing. Some of his teammates are upset and are saying mean things about the other team. Brian joins in with them and called the other team names.
4. David's parents tell him and his little brother to set the table. His little brother doesn't want to do it, and sneaks away. David listens to his parents and sets the table.
5. Katie is playing outside and climbs a tree that her parents have told her not to climb. When she's climbing down, she falls and scratches up her knees. When her mom asks her how it happened, Katie tells her she tripped over a toy in the grass.
6. Kevin is spending the night at his friend's house. His friend wants to watch a movie, but Kevin knows he's not allowed to watch that movie. He doesn't say anything to his friend, and they watch it before going to bed.
7. Megan's dad tells her she needs to get her chores done. She whines about it, but he says she can't go outside and play until she's done. She does her chores, but with a bad attitude.
8. Jessie's teacher is sick, so they have a substitute. The sub tells the class to pull out a book and read. Some of Jessie's classmates object to the substitute teacher, but Jessie pulls out her book and begins to read.
