Alireza Seyyedian is a 39-year-old former Muslim who has been a Christian since 2006. In 2012, security forces removed his computer during a search of his apartment. Authorities then discovered a video of Alireza's baptism on the computer. The judge stated that since Alireza was baptized in Turkey, he was trying to rebel. He was also accused of giving Bibles to youth and sharing worship hymns he had written with them. He has been in prison for three years of a six-year sentence. His mental and physical health is in bad shape due to the conditions of the prison.

2. A bunch of your classmates decide to play kickball while outside at recess. Two captains are chosen to pick teams, and you are one of them. A few rounds of picking goes by, and then you decide to pick a girl who is always the last one to be picked so she won't be the last one this time. Your teammates complain to you about picking her, and the other team starts laughing at you. You tell her you're happy she is on your team.
3. A friend at school took some candy off your teacher's desk when your teacher was not looking. You know it was wrong of him, and tell him that he should tell the teacher and apologize. He tells you that you are stupid for thinking he should apologize and then tells all his friends to call you "stupid."
4. You are at a friend's house and they put in a movie that you know you shouldn't watch. You tell them your parents wouldn't allow you to watch it, but they all call you a baby and start the movie anyway. You leave the room because you know you aren't supposed to watch it.
5. At lunchtime during school, you pray before you begin eating. A boy sitting a few spots down watches and makes fun of you. You tell him you pray because you want to thank God for providing the food. The boy then tells his friends and they start laughing at you.
