	Creative Expressions	<p>Music</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - make up songs about Jesus - sing and do hand motions in Big Group <p>Drama</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - act out Bible stories - do funny skits for your family <p>Artistry</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - decorate your room - paint pictures for friends <p>Writing</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - write a story for your parents - write a poem about God
