



Week 1

Big idea: Paul's initial encounter with Jesus on the road to Damascus led to true life change. We are challenged to evaluate whether we truly have met Jesus in a life-changing way or if we are relying on stories we've learned about Him.

Discussion Questions

- ***This question is designed to take 50%-70% of your group time as everyone answers.*** Follow up on the response element and have students share what their next move is that they marked on their cards. Talk through what the step looks like for each student in your group. ***What is your next move? How did you choose this step next?***
 - Meet Jesus (admit your sin, believe and trust Him with your life)
 - Take it seriously (read scripture often, when reading scripture, make it more than a task to accomplish, pray, be in community, serve)
 - Confess it (continue to confess sin, anger, frustration, etc. rather than letting it take over us).
 - *** Ask students if there is any sin they need to confess to the group and/or to leaders. Loop in your Students' Staff. ***
- Have you truly met Jesus or are you relying on stories you've learned about Him? If you have met Jesus and are following Him, what in your life shows this is true?
- Jesus is creating opportunities where you can see Him working and experience Him more; however, we must be paying attention. Think of your day or past week - where can you look back and see how God is working in your life or in the lives of others?
