Big idea: Jesus ultimately paid a price that we could never pay and gave up his rights for our benefit. We want our students to recognize how they can deny themselves and give up their rights to benefit others just as Paul did.

Discussion Questions

- How is God asking you to move? Encourage your students to share what stood out to them from the teaching and how they may need to move (some steps will become evident from the questions below).
- Paul had a right to make money but chose to make his life more difficult, less comfortable for the sake of other people.
 - When was the last time you made your life LESS comfortable for someone else?
 - What right can you give up to benefit someone else?
- You have a different assignment than Paul, but you must have the same attitude of self-denial. What assignment, or season, are you in currently? How is your attitude about this season or specific situation going in your life?
 - **Leaders**, feelings are great indicators (to point us to what is happening inside of us) but they are not dictators. We want students to genuinely share how they feel but we also need to share.
 - Examples: Not rolling eyes when asked to do something; Keep commitment when something that seems better comes along; Spending free time with a younger sibling or cousin
- Jesus calls us to deny ourselves and live a life of following Him. How do you need to turn away from how you want to live and follow Jesus?
