

# Names of God - Review Huddle



## SETTING THE ATMOSPHERE

As children arrive, collect the “In” slips from parents and see which grade they are in for their huddle teams. Remember to check all slips to make sure children are to be in Up & Out this hour.

### Team Time

Each team leader (student leader) should spend time getting a conversation started within the team to find out more about each child. Spend time today discussing the following questions up front...

- How did you show love for someone else this week or how did someone else show love to you?
- What are you excited about doing this coming week?
- What is your favorite thing ever (could be something you eat, a game, an activity, a holiday)? Why?

### Huddle Teams

- 1st & 2nd grade girls
- 1st & 2nd grade boys
- 3rd & 4th grade girls
- 3rd & 4th grade boys

**LEADERS:** You need to have one set of scavenger hunt answers for yourself. You need to have one set of clues for each team for each service (8 sets if you have 4 teams and 2 services). The sets for the teams need to be cut into individual clues – they are numbered. Each team will also need a pen or pencil.

There is also a Names of God word search that you can use as a competition or just for fun – it is not referenced in this lesson.

### Opening Prayer

Leader prays for the group.

## LESSON HUDDLE

Let's all come over together and get started this morning. Good morning, Up & Out! Where we look up (pause for the group to respond) **TO GOD** and look out (Pause) **TO OTHERS**.

What have we been learning over the past few months? (*Names of God*) Today is our last lesson on Names of God for a while. But, we are not going to learn a new name of God today. We are going to do a review game and then have craft/game time.

Let's start with a Riddle Competition. We will play this game in four teams. (Feel free to adjust number of teams as needed.) I will have clues for each team in the front. You will send one member of your team to the front to retrieve a clue and take it back to your team to figure out the answer together. (*Leaders may make the team members crab walk, walk backwards, skip, etc.*) Once you have your answer, write it on your clue and send it back with another team member. If your answer is correct, I will send another clue to your team. The first team to answer all 10 clues correctly wins.

Let's get started. (PLAY GAME)

Great job guys! Learning some of God's names is a great way to look up to God and learn more about him. The fact that the Bible has over 200 names for Him says He is a BIG, WONDERFUL, AMAZING God that we can always learn more about. Let's pray and thank God for the opportunity to learn more about who he is and who we are in him.
