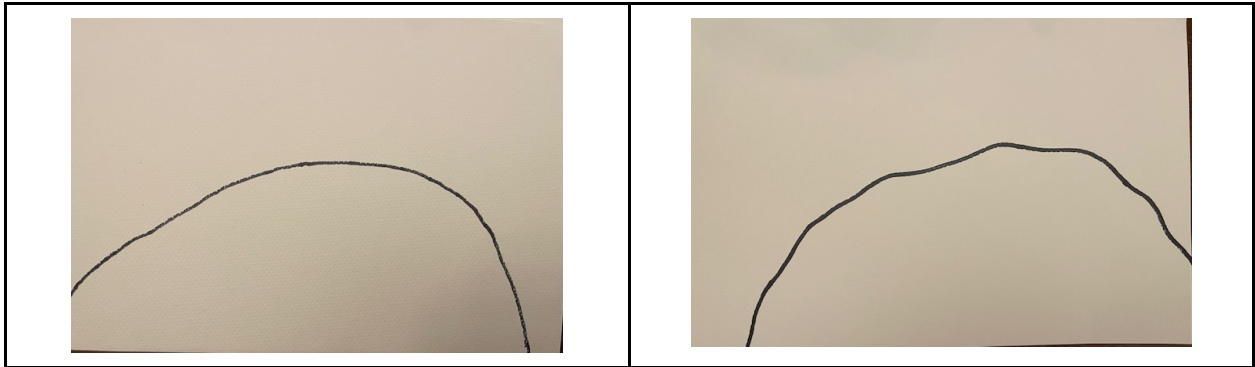


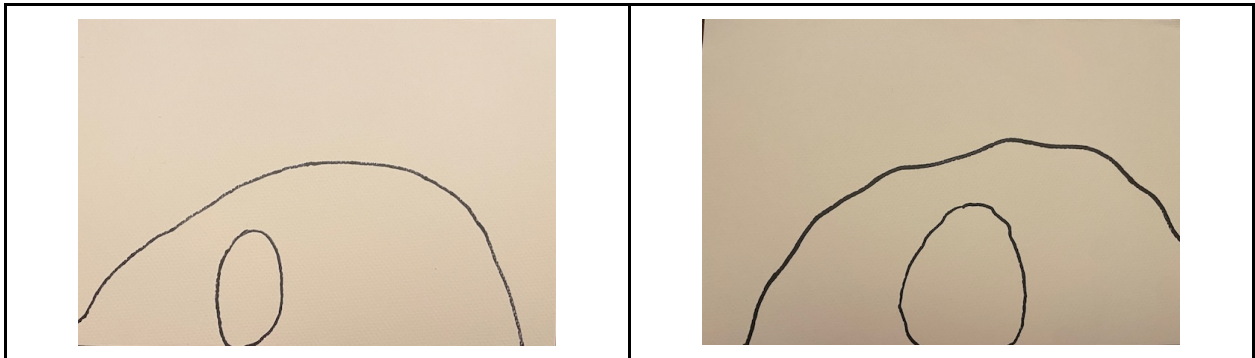
Easter Watercolor Craft

(Two different samples are shown to show variation)

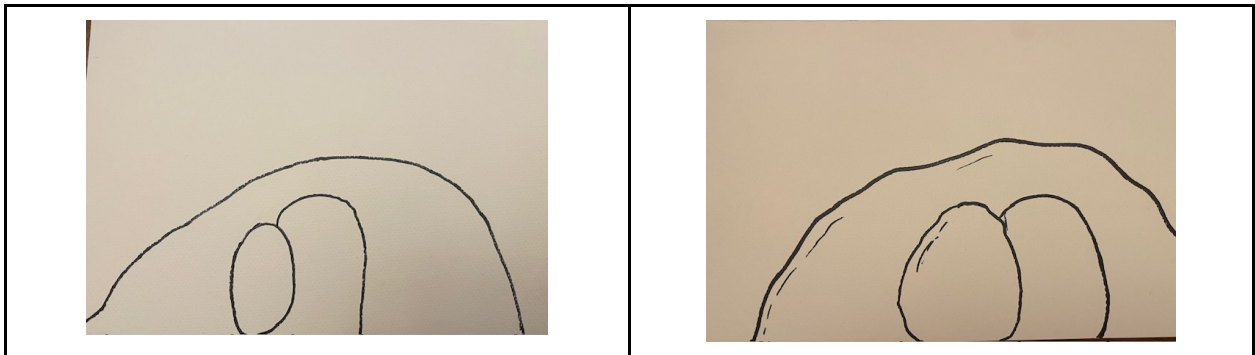
Supplies: Watercolor paper, black marker or crayon, white crayon, paintbrush, watercolor paints (1 set for every 3 children), cup of water



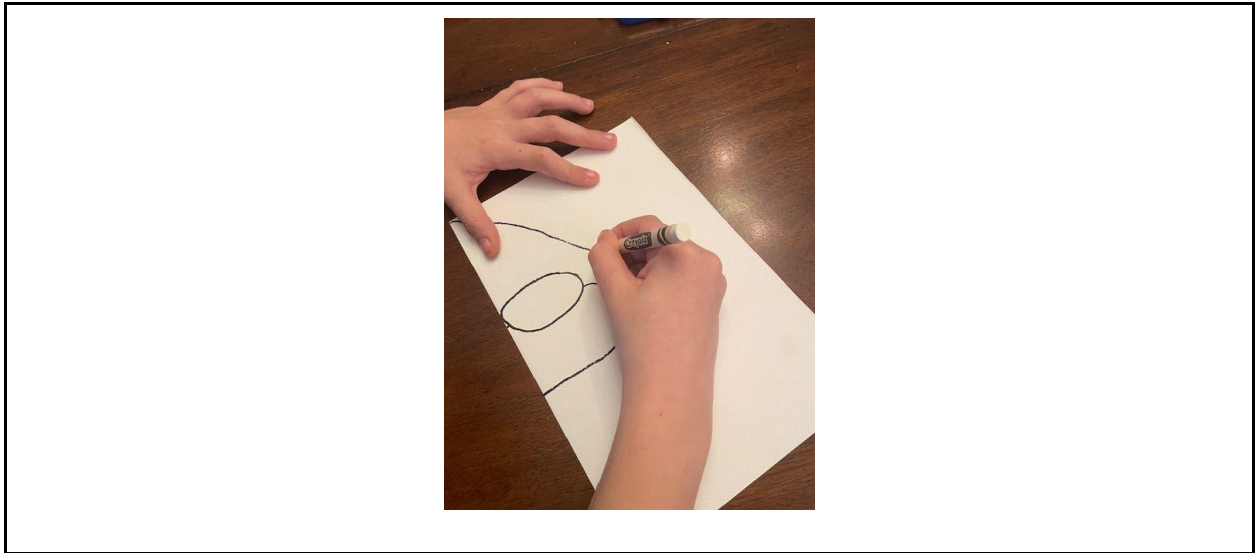
1. Draw the outline of the tomb by starting with a line that touches the bottom of one side of the paper, to the bottom of the other side of the paper.



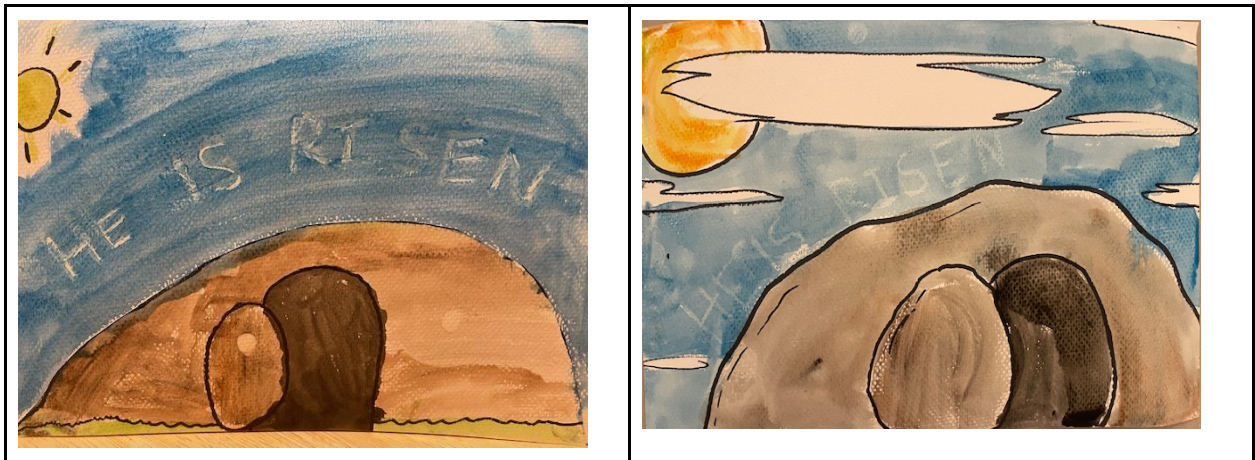
2. Draw the stone first. It should look something like an oval



3. Starting towards the top of the stone, draw a line for the opening of the tomb.



4. In all caps, with a white crayon, write "HE IS RISEN" going over each letter a few times to make sure the letters are thick with the wax crayon. (If the child has difficulty seeing where they have written and it becomes too frustrating, you can offer for them to write it with a black marker.)

5. You can invite the children to add more details, but remind them to try to avoid drawing where they wrote, "HE IS RISEN".
6. Paint the picture using the watercolor paints.
7. If after they paint over their letters, the message is too faint, you can offer for them to outline their message with the black marker or go over the letters with the white crayon again.
